



## CROATIAN CHAMBER OF CHARTERED GEODETIC ENGINEERS

The III Symposium of Chartered Geodetic Engineers was held in Opatija on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2010 which was organized by the Croatian Chamber of Chartered Geodetic Engineers (HKOIG). The Symposium was entitled “GIS, Photogrammetry and Remote Researches Applied in Geodesy and Geoinformatics” with two separate topics “Current Condition and Strategic Interests of the Croatian Geodesy” and “Prices of Geodetic Services” where the proposal for prices of HKOIG services was presented for the first time. The Symposium of Chartered Geodetic Engineers was the central annual meeting within the professional training of chartered geodetic engineers in the Republic of Croatia that is held in Opatija in the congress center Grad Hotela 4 opatijska cvijeta where the Croatian Chamber of Geodetic Engineers will host the CLGE General Meeting in May 2011. The representatives of The Council of European Geodetic Surveyors (CLGE) participated in the Symposium, with President Jean-Yves Pirlot who gave an invited lecture „CLGE, an update“ and Treasurer Dieter Seitz with the lecture “Why a schedule of fees for surveying services is needed and what its contents should be”. Mr. Seitz’s lecture was an introduction to the presentation of the proposal for the HKOIG pricelist for services. An especially interesting called lecture “May the geodetic engineers change the Planet, not only survey it”? was given by the receiver of honorable doctorate degree from the University of Turku, Turku School of Economics, Finland, Prof. Slavica Singer, PhD, Full Professor and Head of Postgraduate Study Entrepreneurship at the Faculty of Economics and Business in Osijek. Some 500 chartered engineers, guests and attendees were gathered at the meeting, and one of them was the Principal of the State Geodetic Administration of the Republic of Croatia, Prof. Željko Bačić, PhD, the Principal of the Croatian Geodetic Institute Prof. Tomislav Bačić, PhD, Ass. Dean of the Faculty of Geodesy, Prof. Siniša Mastelić-Ivić, PhD, the representative of the Institution of Engineers from Slovenia, Principal Section of Geodetic Engineers Matjaž Grilc, and all other guests. The international character of this year Symposium, besides the two above mentioned lectures was also characterized by the lecture by our young colleague Niko Šarlah from friendly and neighboring Slovenia entitled “Collective Cadastre of Public Infrastructure of Slovenia”. The working part of the Symposium was held on Saturday where over 20 colleagues held the presentations of their papers and all the papers were publicized in the Collection of the Symposium that has been regularly published third year consecutively. The Symposium of chartered geodetic engineers had a goal to present the state-of-the-art technologies, their application, exchange experiences and socializing as well.
