To the CLGE members, Dear Friends and Colleagues

The Conference and General Assembly in Bucharest led CLGE another step in the future telling that we have an important role in the development of the European Surveyor. Due to the effort made by President Valeriu Manolache and his team the professional and social outcome of the days in Bucharest will be remembered for a long time.

The next events are on the table and the planning process for the meeting in Bulgaria, Varna is running well. CLGE has in the past five Years created a tradition for Conferences and meetings that calls for a continuous planning of coming events. The Conferences in Umeå 26 – 27 May 2011 and in Germany 12 – 13 October 2012 are in the planning process as well.

The Code of Conduct has been well received and reports of the ratification process are continuously coming to our General Secretary. Lately reports came from Finland, Sweden, Denmark and Germany.

The merging process is running well. Geometer Europas held its Ordinary General Assembly in Brussels on the 8<sup>th</sup> of June confirming the decision about the merging that was taken in Switzerland, Villars, in January 2010. On top of our decision in Bucharest everything is prepared for the execution of the merging in Varna 24 – 25 September. In the history of CLGE it is an important step forward moving the profession into the future.

The number of members in CLGE is now 31. We are in close contact with more potential members and hope to be able to present 2-4 newcomers in Varna. Such a number requires a lot of work in our secretariat and in the near future we must discuss how to handle and secure a high level of services to our members. The expression – passing a point of no return – could be used since the professional demands have increased during the last couple of years. The need of following the legislation in EU calls for a lot of work hardly to be handled on a voluntarily basis. Supporting our members in national matters is also an important part of the CLGE responsibility and the need for it has increased significantly.

The summer is ahead of us. The economical crisis is slowly on return although still affecting the private and public sector amongst our members. I hope that the initiatives from the governments and from EU will make a recovery visible and generate activity for the surveying profession.

In Varna, CLGE will as a result of the merging process, elect a new Board to carry CLGE into the future. I have had the honour of being president since autumn 2005 and am proud of being able to carry out the election process in Varna.
