- Estonian Agricultural University
- Tallinn University of Technology
- Tallinn College of Engineering
- Kehtna Economy and Technology School

Estonian Agricultural University

- Bachelor level studies in Geomatics
 - 3 years
 - 50 Bachelor-Students per year
 - Geodesy, real estate planning, land management
- Master level studies in Geomatics
 - 2 years
 - 40 Master-Students per year
 - Geodesy, real estate planning, land management
- Doctor level studies in Geodesy
 - 4 years, 2 students today

Tallinn University of Technology

- Engineering studies
 - 5 years
 - Graduates will receive masters degree
 - 12 students
 - Construction surveys

Tallinn College of Engineering

- Applied higher education - diploma studies
 - 4 years
 - 25 students
 - Construction surveys

Kehtna Economy and Technology School

- Vocational education
 - Studies base on secondary school education
 - 2 years 6 months
 - 15 Students per year
 - Surveying
