

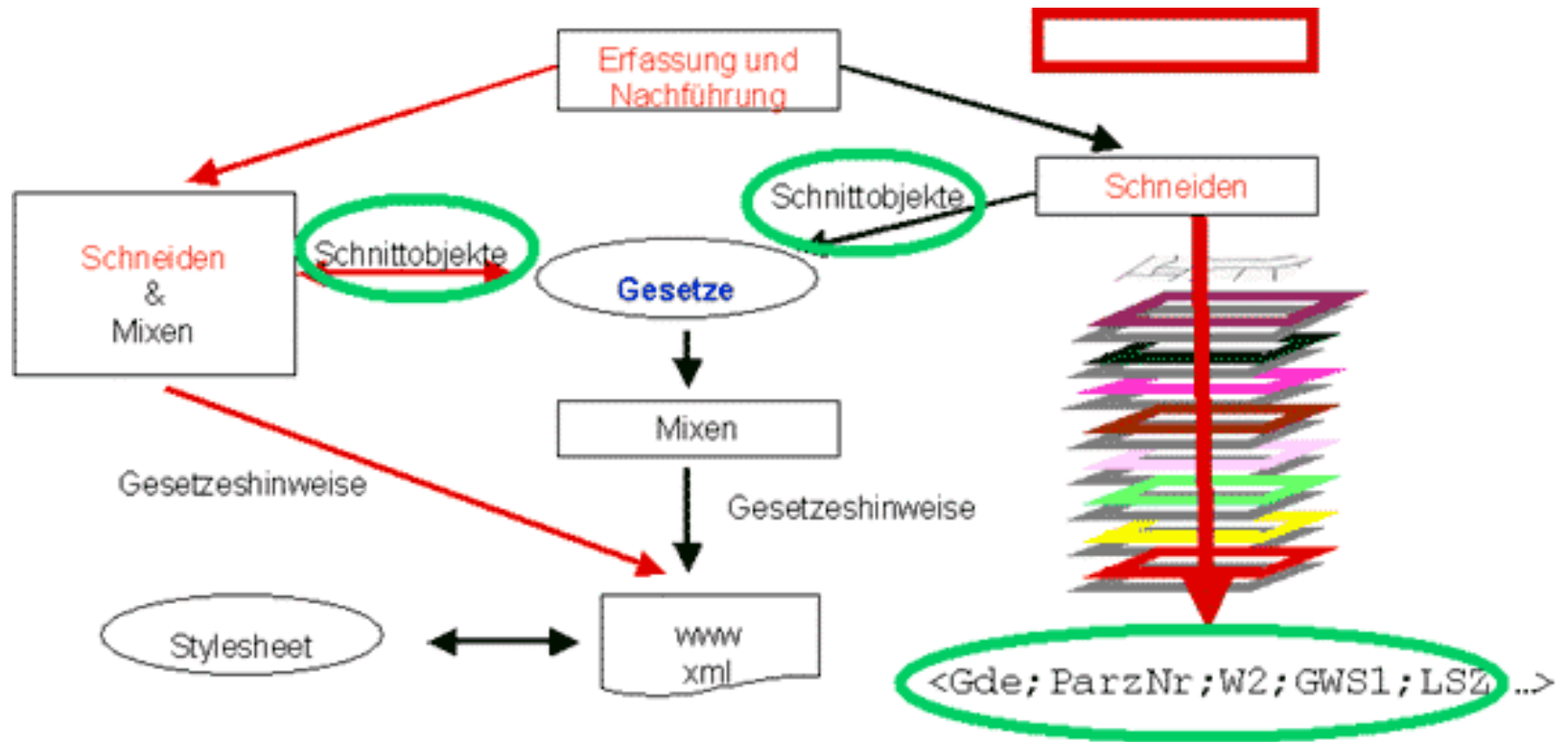

Based on the FIG Cadastre 2014 publication the free practicing colleagues have launched a cooperative society called c2014, which has done considerable work in scanning laws to identify geographically defined public-law restrictions of the property rights. The laws have been modeled with the help of the Swiss data modeling language INTERLIS and the software has been developed to find out which parcels are concerned with restrictions. This information shall be made available to the public by the c2014 internet-portal. 2005 this solution shall be operational. geosuisse supports this initiative.



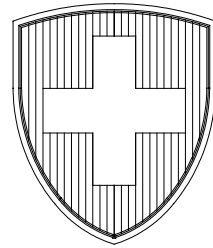
## **Bundesgesetz über Geoinformation (Geoinformationsgesetz, GeoIG)**

In Switzerland the Law on Geoinformation has been drafted with strong support by the geosuisse professionals including the president. This law shall regulate the issue of geodata on national level and is also legal basis for the cadastre on public-law restrictions on land property. It showed that the definition of basic geodata must be based on the existing legislation.



Also in the development of a National Geo Data Infrastructure (NGDI) which is pushed by an initiative of the federal coordination body on geoinformation KOGIS which acts under an interdepartmental Steering Committee and is subordinated to swisstopo. This initiative called e-geo.ch shall be developed to a programme where all interested governmental levels and also private organizations contribute to the development of NGDI. The president of geosuisse is member of the Steering Committee as representative of the 'data producing' and 'data maintaining' organizations.

In the domain of land management, geosuisse has sponsored different seminars in cooperation with private and governmental partners. Emphasis is placed on this domain, because in the field of geomatics the initial data acquisition work for the cadastral surveying is coming to an end.



The institute of the license for official surveyors has been questioned by the federal council under the title of deregulation. We try to convince our politicians that the Private Public Partnership solution in Switzerland's cadastre survey has been a successful operation and that the institute was an act of deregulation from the beginning.
