CADASTRE AND LAND REGISTRY EXPERT GROUP

- ❖ working body dealing with professional issues in cadastre and land registry, started at the end of 2004;
- ❖ raising awareness on actual cadastre and land registry issues in EuroGeographics' member organizations and in European environment;
- ❖ long term ambition: becoming a driving force in European environment - value added non-competitive cooperation, partnerships, openness, lobbying, raising professional profile.



EXPERT GROUP WORKPLAN

- ✓ information resource – to allow ‘benchmarking’ of Members’ organisations;
- ✓ visions – development of a new vision for cadastre and land registry organizations;
- ✓ role of the cadastral parcel in INSPIRE and SDIs (in cooperation with the PCC);
- ✓ cross border mortgaging and mortgage credit;
- ✓ ‘PPP’ in Cadastre;
- ✓ platform for information exchange;
- ✓ workshops and meetings.

- ❑ main tasks: 1st priority: an inventory on general information about land surveyors activities,

2nd priority: proposals for professional standards (PPP models, training, education), best practice on developing PPP between NMCAs and surveyors communities;

- ❑ milestones: kick-off meeting in Paris - 13-14 Dec, 2006 (GE); distribution of a questionnaire to EG, CLGE, GE member organizations - end of March 2007; meeting in Brussels - 17-18 April 2007; final report and plan for follow-up activities - by the end September 2007;
- ❑ cooperation: CLGE and Geometer Europas
