- Latvia – lack of graduates (historical)
- Germany – Scientific/engineering courses
- Netherlands – closure of course in Delft
- France – reversing trends with marketing
- UK – lack of undergraduates & technicians
- Denmark – sister campus in Copenhagen

Increasing needs of market for professional surveyors

- **CLERGEOT** – insufficient numbers of graduates in ~50% of countries
- **DENMARK** – unemployment of surveyors 0,5% - lowest of all professions
- High demand from GI & construction sectors – **INSPIRE Directive, Galileo, PSI Directive, GMES**

Improve communication to potential students
