



Memorandum of Understanding CLGE - EGOS

Preamble

The Council of European Geodetic Surveyors (CLGE) and the European Group of Surveyors (EGoS) consider themselves as complementary organizations in the field of surveying.

Therefore, the organizations want to establish an enduring partnership to support their common activities.

Purpose

The MoU is intended to facilitate communication, coordination and cooperation between the signatory organizations. The purpose of the MoU is twofold:

- To build capacity in the surveying, as defined by FIG (e.g. surveying, valuation, mapping, cadastral systems, geo-information ...);
- To promote the role of surveying in Europe;

Objectives

1. Capacity building

Identify areas for cooperation and, as appropriate, implement joint projects to support:

- the education of surveyors to meet the requirements in the public and private sectors;
- continued professional development (CPD) and life long learning for surveyors.

2. Promotion of the role of surveying

- Share information and analysis of relevant EU regulations and programmes;
- Act together to promote the role of surveying within the above and international regulations and programmes;
- Integrate actions and visibility towards the European bodies, the international and national authorities as well the European consumer.


Basis of cooperation

The Secretary Generals will recommend joint actions to the signatory organizations according to the Memorandum of Understanding, complemented by a yearly meeting of the Presidents. The MoU will be evaluated after a three year period, to be renewed in 2011.
