

## The Council of European Geodetic Surveyors Comité de Liaison des Géomètres Européens

The Conference organised by the Research Institute of Geodesy, Topography and Cartography was entitled "Our Profession in Europe without Barriers". In excess of 40 participants attended the two day conference with over 50% being from outside the Czech Republic and a number of CLGE representatives took part.

The Conference was held at the same time as the 3<sup>rd</sup> International Fair of Geodesy, Cartography, Navigation and Geoinformatics.

The conference topics ranged from in depth technical issues associated with First Order Triangulation to the Prevention and Management of Physical Disasters and the Surveyors Involvement to more Business related areas covered by INSPIRE and Cadstre.

The major session topic embraced six areas.

- 1. Our Profession in Europe with Barriers
- 2. Geoinformtion and GIS, Cartography and Map creation
- 3. Navigation Systems and Services Based on Location
- 4. Cadastre of Real Estate
- 5. Basic Geodetic Control and Geodetic Work
- 6. Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing

The conference provided a good forum to explore the integration and development of ideas facing the profession in many European countries.
