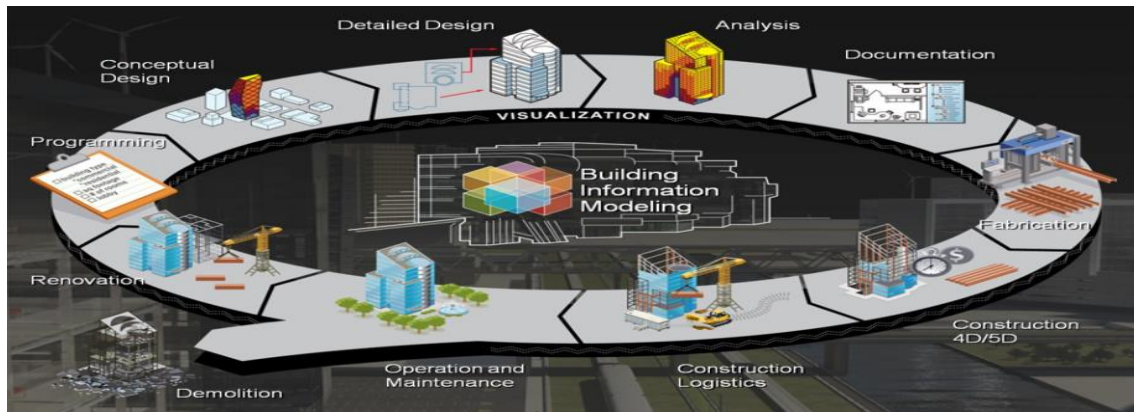


BUILDING INFORMATION MODELLING (BIM)



The policy makers of the European Union have taken a significant step forward in ensuring that Building Information Modelling (BIM) technologies and practices become mandatory for all projects undertaken in the EU. A revision of the procurement directive is to embrace BIM and digital working for public contracts.

BIM is a collaborative way of working, underpinned by the digital technologies which unlock more efficient methods for designing, creating and maintaining our assets.

BIM embeds key product and asset data and a 3 dimensional computer model that can be used for effective information management throughout a project lifecycle – from earliest concept to the operation.

Surveyors may have an important role on this technology, leading the approach to data analysis and data management
