- ❑ Native French and Italian languages, speaks German and English



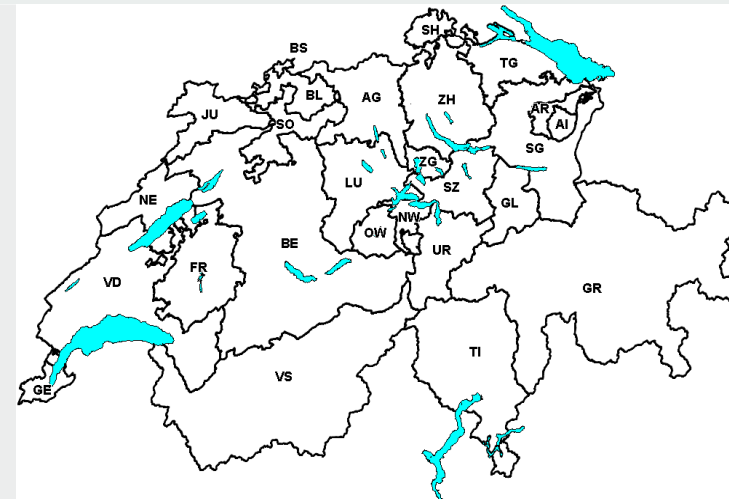
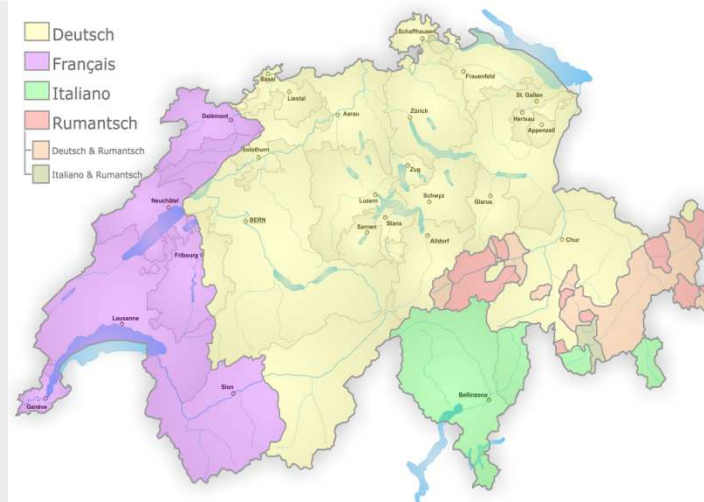
My goals for the CLGE:
