Background



- Establishment at the FIG Congress in Munich in 2006
 - *Initial purpose was to bring more YS into FIG, as Commission 1 'Working Group - 1.2 Working Group Young Surveyors'. In 2009 the working group was upgraded to a Young Surveyors Network in Eilat, Israel. The experience we gathered and input we delivered over the last years led to a much broader range of tasks and audience.*
- The FIG YSN organises various events all over the world in co-operation with leading associations and world-leading businesses like CLGE, UN-Habitat, World Bank, FAO, Trimble, Topcon, Leica, ESRI etc.
- Those co-operations and partnerships are the key in showing that it is our generation who are the ambassadors and agents of change.
