



3D-Cadastral Systems 21st - 22nd June 2016

Some countries in Europe have adopted a 3D-cadastre or they are implementing it at the moment. Some countries have already got experiences how to handle 3D-cadastre and the rest of us could learn from their valuable experience of difficulties in practice or advantages that their systems have. The Finnish 3D-cadastre is targeted to be introduced in the the year 2017.
