67 times of participation (71 entries)

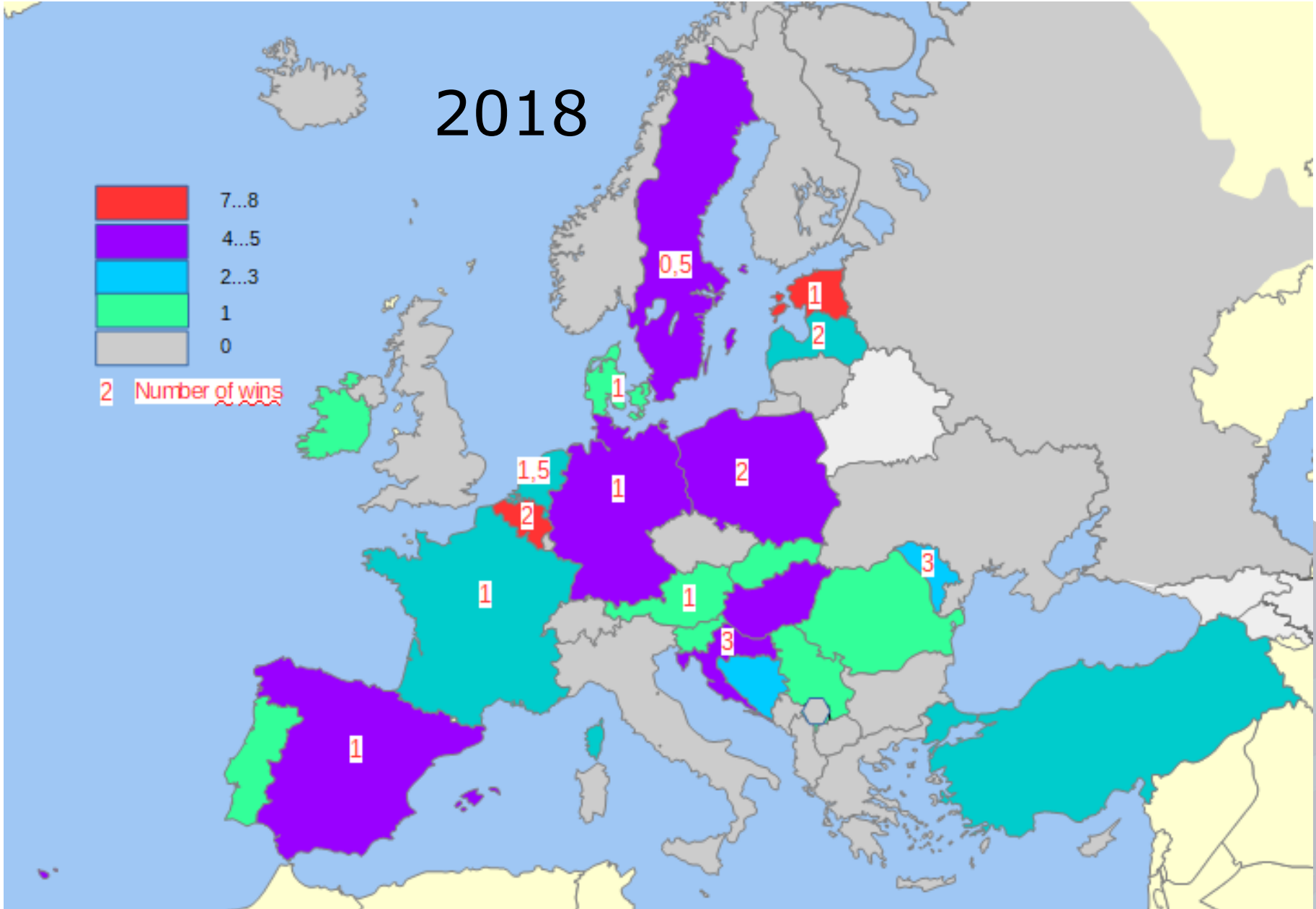
20 winners (Prices = 20 000 EUR)
