Gathered during the IV CLGE Conference of the European Surveyor and GI, in Kaliningrad (Russian Federation), 1 – 3 July 2014, the European Surveyors have conducted interesting and very fruitful talks.

Once more we acknowledge the need for a strong and specific, initial academic and practical education as well as high quality continuing professional development courses.

Regarding the historic geodetic infrastructure related to the Struve Geodetic Arc, we ask the responsible authorities of the Russian Federation to make the required efforts to renovate, maintain and give expert access to the reference points on Hogland.


Moreover, in the field of modern Geodesy, CLGE strongly supports Galileo and GLONASS as important Global Navigation Satellite Systems and the European contribution to worldwide satellite navigation and positioning.

We see the need for further standardisation to guarantee interoperable solutions.
