

How to join **CLGE** >>

Applications to join CLGE must be submitted in writing to the Secretary General. The applicant must provide:

- confirmation that it represents the majority of Geodetic Surveying professionals in a particular country
- the level of academic qualifications of its members, and
- the professional disciplines practised by its members.

If the criteria for membership are met, the Executive Board will propose acceptance of the application to the General Assembly. The decision to accept the application requires a two-thirds majority.

We are the European Council of Geodetic Surveyors.

We represent and promote the interests of the geodetic surveying profession in the private and public sector in Europe, especially:

- The creation of a permanent forum for European geodetic surveyors, who are committed to European co-operation
- The promotion and exchange of technical, scientific, educational and organisational knowhow within the European states
- The provision of assistance to member countries, to national associations and EU institutions.



★ Objective

CLGE represents and promotes the geodetic surveying profession within Europe through:

- A permanent forum for Geodetic Surveyors working in Europe
- A commitment to cooperation and partnership within the profession in Europe
- Exchange of knowledge and expertise between professionals across national and international borders
- Provision of consultation and advice to member countries, national associations and the European Union
- Maintenance and enhancement of professional qualifications and standards of services throughout member countries
- Representation of the profession to European authorities and governments
- Participation in other relevant organisations within Europe and worldwide.

CLGE membership is divided into two categories: *Principal members* and *Observers*. CLGE can award individuals with Honorary Membership.

★ Principal Members

- Association or National Liaison Group that represents the majority of the geodetic surveying profession in any European country
- Only one membership per state is permitted
- Have one vote at General Assemblies cast by their leading delegate.

★ Observers

- Observer status is permitted from any European country, normally during the application procedure for membership
- The General Assembly may bestow observer status on: associations representing a group of geodetic surveyors, or an individual geodetic surveyor, or European Institutions
- Observers may attend a General Assembly meeting but they do not vote.

★ Honorary Members

Honorary membership is awarded to an individual by the General Assembly following a recommendation from the Executive Board, to acknowledge exceptional service to CLGE.
