Dear Members, Colleagues and Friends,

We are pleased to present the interim six-monthly report for the first semester of 2021.

CLGE has had a busy start to 2021 with a new President and Executive Board, elected in September 2020, taking up the reins. We have successfully organised the full complement of Executive Board meetings, Bureau meetings and the first General Assembly of 2021. We continue to meet in so called hybrid or blended mode – a mix of people both online and physically gather and this is working well. It gives everyone the chance to participate whatever their personal and national circumstances may be from time-to-time. We have leveraged our existing investment in Microsoft 365, in particular the Microsoft Teams application, with no additional software licensing costs to widen digital participation for our regular meetings. In 2020, with help from CLGE Vice President Michalis Kalogiannakis, we invested in high quality portable audio-visual equipment to support this hybrid way of working. We continue to benefit from this smart investment. Nevertheless, we prefer to meet with our members in person and we encourage this whenever possible. For some very large events such as the annual Global Surveyors' Day we occasionally need to use different digital platforms which are more appropriate the format of the meeting. We will continue to review our technology choices to ensure that we are getting best value for CLGE whilst delivering the quality of experience that our participants expect.

We announced a new theme of the year 2021, a new Global Surveyor of the Year, a new Students Contest and the GISCAD-OV project continues apace. We are increasingly posting regular news updates to our new [website](#) as well as on [LinkedIn](#) and these are certainly the best way to keep up-to-date with what's happening here at CLGE. However, we recognise that some of our followers like to read a periodic consolidated digest of what we are up to and that's the purpose of these interim and annual newsletters which we are continuing to produce. The FIG Young Surveyors Network (YSN) was first established as the Working Group 1.2: 'Young Surveyors Working Group' of FIG Commission 1 at the XXIII FIG Congress (2006) held in Munich, Germany.

The Young Surveyors Working Group was later upgraded to the Young Surveyors Network during the 2009 FIG Working Week in Eilat, Israel. The Network was established with the main aim to

create an environment that encourages the active participation of young surveyors in the work of FIG, as well as its 10 commissions.

The Network has created an environment for young surveyors from different cultures, with different academic backgrounds and professional experiences from all over the globe to come together and learn from each other towards the sustenance of the surveying profession. The Network has held many meetings, workshops, and conferences all over the world. These have been done in conjunction and/or with the support of leading bodies such as the UN-Habitat, the World Bank, CLGE, and the UN Food and Agriculture Organisation.

From the beginning of 2021, Kwabena Obeng Asiama (Ghana/Germany) is now Chair and Ferah Pirlanta Köksal is the Vice Chair of FIG YSN. Ferah is also the FIG YSEN Delegate to the CLGE Executive Board and we send both her and Kwabena our many congratulations and good luck in their new roles. The Young Surveyors are currently organising the [6th FIG Young Surveyors Conference](#) and working on several projects with many volunteer Young Surveyors from all around the world.

Croatian Earthquake Appeal



In December 2020 a strong earthquake struck central Croatia which severely impacted several of our colleagues in the region. The Croatian Chamber of Geodetic Engineers responded by providing some financial relief to meet the immediate needs of our colleagues and has requested further support from CLGE. Year of Women in Surveying 2021





Global Surveyor's Day 2021



Our first major event of 2021 was the Global Surveyor's Day which took place March 23rd (because the 21st was on a Sunday). We ran this 90 minute event at late 21:00 Central European Time to give our colleagues in Africa, Middle East, Asia, Oceania and the Americas the opportunity to join us. In 2021 this ran as an online event for which over 900 people worldwide signed up. The event was hosted by CLGE President Vladimir Krupa. After Vladimir's opening remarks we were treated to three welcoming addresses from Frédérique Ries MEP, Professor Rudolf Staiger, FIG President and Marc Vanderschueren, Chair of the Forum of Regional Bodies (FoRB). Next up was Blaženka Mičević with a presentation on CLGE Theme of the Year 2021 'Women in Surveying' which is also the CLGE Theme of the Year 2021. This series was complemented by a number of talking head statements from representatives of FoRB from around the world. Following this session Mairolt Kakko, Chair of the CLGE Vetting Committee announced the winners of the CLGE Students' Contest on the Move 2020, who we warmly congratulate. The finale of the evening was the unveiling of the Global Surveyor of the Year 2021, Johann Carl Friedrich Gauss, by Prof. Dr. Hansjörg Kutterer, President of DVW and CLGE President Vladimir Krupa. 6th FIG Young Surveyors Conference



On 15 May 2021, CLGE President Vladimir Krupa and CLGE Vice-President Jānis Klīve took part in the 6th FIG Young Surveyors Conference. In his opening address President Krupa emphasised that CLGE has a long tradition of supporting the FIG Young Surveyors European Network. Vladimir also commended the Conference theme of ‘*Challenges in our New Reality Reimagining a Sustainable Future*’ and alignment with the UN Sustainable Development Goals 2030. He went on stressing the importance of international coalitions and how CLGE continues to make the case for the [International Ethics Standards Coalition \(IESC\)](#) to adopt “Sustainability” as one of the explicit Ethical Principles. Vladimir concluded by noting that CLGE is putting its own house in order too, by checking what we can do to decrease our carbon footprint and compensating the emissions that we cannot avoid through a cooperation with the German Company called Atmosfair.
