Who can take part?

If you (or you and your teammates) are 35 years old or less and you have undertaken your thesis or some research work at a European university in geodesy, cadastre, mapping or geoinformation or if you have a nice project in mind, in one of these fields, you are welcome to participate in the CLGE Young Surveyors' Contest! Your work has to be finished this year or within the last 3 years.



What you should do?

All you have to do is to complete the Contest Poster limited to one page with general information about your work. The Contest Poster includes four sections - a template is attached.

'Print' the poster in pdf before sending it. Maximum 3 illustrations may be attached in usual formats (jpg, tiff, pdf,...).

Note, that by participating you are accepting the use of your data and publication of your information by CLGE concerning the Contest.



When?
