FACTS...

- 70% of human population will live in urban centers by 2050
- About 2.5 billion people could be added to urban areas by the same date
- Cities occupy 2% of the earth's surface and produce 80% of greenhouse gas emissions

What does
CONDOMINIUM
mean?

The term "CONDOMINIUM" originates from Latin and means "joint sovereignty"

or in other words

"The concept of individual ownership rights in a common property".



What does
CONDOMINIUM
mean?

A building or complex in which units of property, such as apartments, are owned by individuals and common parts of the property, such as the grounds and building structure, are owned jointly by the unit owners.

CONDOMINIUM DEFINITION

A condominium, is a type of living space (often, but not necessarily, similar to an apartment) but independently sellable and therefore regarded as real estate.

The **condominium** building structure is divided into several units that are each separately owned, surrounded by **common areas that are jointly owned**.








MEASUREMENT BUILDING PLOT






european Real Estate Area Label

- www.euREAL.eu
- A unified code for the measurement of surfaces in Buildings
- 2007 –First ideas about a standard
- September 2011 Adoption in Tallinn
- Embedded in European Law via the INSPIRE Directive
 - integrated into Annex III of the INSPIRE directive
- Was welcomed by the INSPIRE as a 'Visionary Cross Border Tool for Transparency'



CONCLUSIONS 1/5

1. The CONDOMINIUM system exists in all IG-PARLS countries

2. In some countries CONDOMINIUM has a long tradition, in others was introduced at the end of the last century

3. Today we live in a period of extraordinary urbanization, due to a lack of space, we are creating higher and higher multi-apartment buildings, so the system of CONDOMINIUM ownership is more relevant than ever.

CONCLUSIONS 2/5

4. The process of registration of CONDOMINIUMS does not follow the trends of digitalization – documentation is still on paper in most countries (floor plans, division plans ...).

There are some exceptions – CH, DK, and SI.

5. Some countries are developing their systems in the direction of 3D cadastre (CH, HR, and SI). Slovenia already has an established and functioning BUILDING CADASTRE for the whole country, which enables the 3D registration of condominiums.

CONCLUSIONS 3/5


6. The development challenges of condominium registration go in the direction of 3D cadastre and connection with BIM.

7. The role of the Property surveyor in the process of registration of condominiums is satisfactory in most of the IG-PARLS countries.

The technical part of the process (measuring the plot and the building, making floor plans and division plans...) is in the domain of the Property surveyor, but registration in the Land register is almost everywhere the responsibility of a notary.


CONCLUSIONS 4/5

9. Digitization and modernization of the process of registration of condominiums in the direction of 3D cadastre represent a great challenge for surveyors and at the same time an opportunity for an important segment of the work of surveying companies in the future.





