- Continuous Professional Development, lifelong learning (CPD)



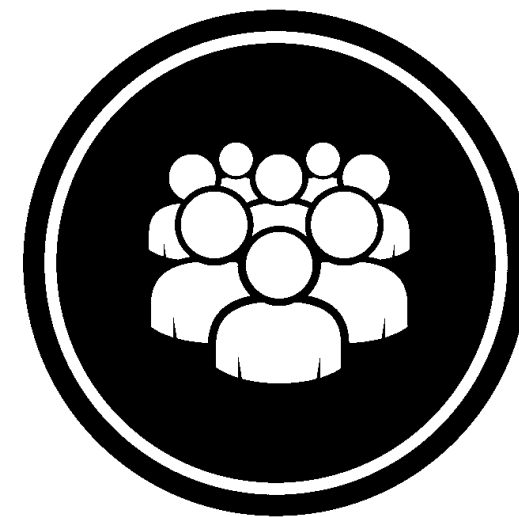
Objective 2: Demonstrate to decision makers that our profession is essential to serve the general interest
