## Who can take part?

If you, or you and your teammates, are 35 years old or less and you have undertaken your thesis or some research work at a European university in the department of geodesy, cadastre, mapping or geoinformation or if you have a relevant project in mind, in one of these fields, you are welcome to participate in the CLGE Young Surveyors' Contest 2026! Your work must have been finalised within the last 3 years, i.e. between 1 January 2023 and 13 July 2026.

## What you should do?

All you need to do is to complete the Contest Application form, limited to 1000 words, with general information about your work. The Contest Application includes four sections – a template is attached. Please complete your Application and save it in pdf format, before submitting. A maximum of 5 illustrations may be embedded in your submission. The Contest Jury will select the best applicants to participate in the Online Finals and present their work and to select the winners. Please note, that by participating you are accepting the use of your data and publication of your work by CLGE.

## Why participate?

The prizes are €1500 for the winner or the winning team, the 2<sup>nd</sup> place receives €1000 and the 3<sup>rd</sup> place €500. Moreover, winners will be invited to the awarding ceremony as guests of CLGE. We will fund their attendance, travel and hotel costs. Winners or participants can improve their CV and meet industry experts, leaders as well as colleagues from other European countries at the awarding ceremony.
